


Words from the President

NEW MEMBER PROFILE -

PATTY AND CHARLIE HANOVER



When Patty met Charlie, they were both students at Purdue. First to graduate, Charlie worked for a couple of years in Indianapolis and Ft. Wayne; after Patty finished school, the couple found jobs together and moved to Carmel.

An electrical and biomedical engineer. Charlie

originally worked for companies that were developing electronics for Delco. Redefining himself, he then worked in the biomedical field until retiring in 2018. Patty worked for Lilly for 37 years doing pharmaceutical research, retiring in 2017.

As "retirees," the Hanovers are busy with friends, kids/grandkids, and volunteering in a variety of places. Active in their church, they play bells in the choir and serve on several committees.

On the board of local community theater group Carmel Community Players, Charlie builds sets and helps behind the scenes producing plays. He drives the van for the local senior community center, taking seniors to their appointments. Active with the TriMedx Foundation (the philanthropic arm of his former biomedical employer), Charlie spends several weeks each year at their U.S. centers testing and repairing medical equipment to be distributed to hospitals in third world countries. In April, Charlie will travel to Kenya to repair equipment at two hospitals there.

Patty volunteers extensively at church, serving on the Personnel committee and the Nominating Committee. She is responsible for the church's member database and schedules activities in the building. During income tax season, Patty volunteers with AARP, helping seniors and low income

individuals prepare their tax returns.

With both time and energy to take to the road and the skies, the Hanovers take two major trips a year - one international and one driving trip around the U.S. In March they ski with friends in Colorado. In spring, summer, and fall, most weekends are spent at their Tippecanoe lake house, where Patty loves to cook and entertain, sharing "their lake" with kids, family, and friends. Charlie loves driving the boat, photograph, and heading out for bicycle trips.

With their two children married and living locally (Fishers and Westfield), Charlie and Patty get to see their grandkids quite often, in fact babysitting once a week for their son's children. Everyone has a busy schedule, but these grandparents make staying close to their kids/grandkids their most important hobby. Just a few weeks ago, they took everyone to the circus. Conner Prairie's Merry Christmas event is another outing to enjoy with the young'uns.

Almost twenty years ago, Patty and Charlie began taking dance lessons at Arthur Murray in preparation for their daughter's wedding. Realizing this was something they really enjoyed doing together, they've taken lessons off-and-on at the Carmel Monon Center. Then, around three years ago, deciding they wanted to get better, they started lessons at La Danse. Now "hooked", the couple dances at the Indiana Roof year-round, and joined Continental so as to have the opportunity to practice more often. They really enjoyed the Starlite New Year's Eve dance last year and are planning to go again this year.

The Hanovers really enjoy doing the swing - so fun, active, and versatile. (The swing is the go-to dance at weddings and at Purdue's annual Boiler-maker Ball, Patty notes). The pair is starting to get comfortable enough with some of the other dances. "With us," Patty confesses, "it takes a long time to get anything new into our muscle memory!"




CLUB RULES: Membership may be terminated for the following reasons:
