Goals from our Board of Directors

Fellow CDC members,

The Board of Directors met on January 17th to explore our goals for 2024. We want to ensure club members are aware of our plans and how members can be involved. Pearl Spinner and Dave Berard were not able to join us but were aware of the meeting and provided input.

- 1. Update to the By-Laws and Standing Rules around the nomination and election process. This committee is already composed. The committee is comprised of two Board members: Susan Crawley and Dave Berard, as well as members: Roger Greenawalt, Diane Rice, and Lynda Lilly.
- 2. CDC contributes to KDO (Kids Dance Outreach) through the 50/50 weekly raffle at our Sunday night dances. CDC has donated to this charity for many years. This charity also receives funding from the Lilly Endowment, amongst other organizations. There are other ballroom dance organizations (children and adult) that could benefit from our weekly contributions. The Board is going to look into supporting other organizations and will continue to support KDO until a decision has been made. The Board welcomes your suggestions if you are aware of an organization.
- 3. The Board discussed having T-shirts made with the CDC logo. BOLD (Benefits of Learning Dance) has partnered with Bonfire (an on-line apparel shop) to design and sell T-shirts and sweatshirts. The Board is looking for club members to serve on a committee to investigate utilizing Bonfire or a similar company to design apparel for CDC that members can purchase. A Board member will also be on the committee.

If you are interested in assisting with goals 2 and 3, please contact a Board member. The 2024 Board of Directors will communicate the progress of each goal throughout the year.

Born in Middlebury, Indiana, CDC member Rob Slabach has lived in many places. His work as a respiratory therapist led to assignments as a polysomnographer (doing sleep studies) in different locations in the USA; his missionary work took him to Africa for three different periods in his life.

Dancing continues to be a big part of Rob's life "back home in Indiana" - he takes group lessons at Aurelia's in Westfield, at ABC Ballroom, and at Continental. He enjoys the challenge of Samba and Quickstep, and loves Waltz and Night Club Two Step. (Actually, his favorite dance he admits, is whichever one he's dancing with a lady who can follow well and keep time.)






CLUB RULES: Membership may be terminated for the following reasons:
