MY CDC Kay Tawney



Eleven years ago, on the very day she had retired from her medical practice at University Hospitals in Cleveland, Ohio, Kay Tawney moved to Indiana to be close to one of her two daughters. She's enjoyed watching her grand-daughter grow, and see her become involved in many middle school activities.

After growing up in Seattle, Washington, Kay has lived in

Texas and Washington D.C. Her longest stint, she reveals, was in Ohio, where, as a result of an early


















CLUB RULES: Membership may be terminated for the following reasons:
